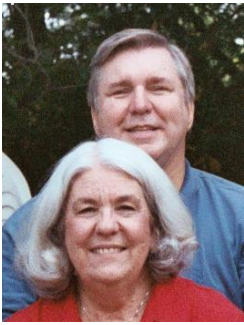


Hill Mission Report

Dear Brethren,

Good news! The result of the most recent CT Scan (January 31, 2012) shows that the cancerous nodules in my lungs have decreased an average of two millimeters and the cancer in my lymph nodes has completely disappeared. To God be the glory! But, while it is true that I have cancer and there is a lot to do yet on that front, it does not mean that I have stopped working for our Lord.

More good news! My doctor has approved a mission trip for me this year to Zambia, Central Africa. There is a chemo therapy treatment in which tablets are used and I will be able to take the tablets while in Zambia. This trip is planned for August 06 – 30, 2012. Needless to say, I am more than a little excited about being able to go into Africa and work for our Lord once again. However, I will need your prayerful and financial help.

Since I didn't go to Zambia last year I feel the need to raise more funds for our use in the work of **International Bible Teaching Ministries** this year. Below is a list of these needed funds.

Greetings from Georgia!

I have to say the most exciting news around our house right now is the report on Jimmie's cancer. God is so wonderful to answer prayers so I want to thank you again for yours on our behalf. And now it looks like Jimmie will be able to resume his campaign work as well. I think he was even more thrilled about that!

Jimmie didn't mention it but besides being back to his campaign plans he has resumed other duties that had been interrupted, like preaching, teaching, assisting students, and writing a new course for our online study program. He also re-arranged his chemo schedule so that we can begin traveling on the weekends again. So if you would like him to present the work of **IBTM** and how your congregation can get involved, just let him know.

We especially need more faithful brethren to get involved in teaching our online students. All those months in 2010 that I spent uploading materials onto our websites and getting the correspondence courses ready for study I wondered how long it would take people to find them. As it turned out – no time at all!

In 2011 our websites had 62,925 visitors coming from 198 nations and 2,673 cities around the world. Even dreaming big I never expected that!

Of those who came 1,902 enrolled in our online Bible study. Now at least 56 of these students have graduated, but many of the others are still actively studying our 6-course program. And we got word that 1 has been baptized! (Others may have been as well, but we have not yet heard back from the local brethren Jimmie contacted.) What an amazing start to this online work!

And January 2012 began with a bang. We had a record number of website visits – 11,111 – and a record number of new students enrolling – 327. Apparently New Year's Resolutions are a worldwide custom. The flood of students has certainly kept our extraordinary team of teachers hopping.

Our teachers have been absolutely wonderful. I never heard the first complaint, even on those days when I thought I was drowning in emails. But to keep this surge going we need more teachers. Good teachers are the key to this program and we can't grow without them. If you want to be part of the team, please contact Jimmie or me.
