Dear brethren,

Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Since our last Newsletter we have sent books and assignments to the 20 new students we signed up for classes with our distance learning program. I have been visiting our regular supporting churches for the past several weeks and plan to be visiting more in the next few weeks.

I just returned on October 30th from a mission trip to Uganda, East Africa. Brother Jerry Sullins and I made this trip. We taught 3 hours each Monday through Friday during our stay there. We were teaching at the East Africa School of Biblical Studies in Kampala, Uganda a city of about 2 million people. On Saturday Oct. 23rd we conducted a preacher seminar for the former graduates and current students of the school. There were 18 of the 20 men who graduated and the current students present for the seminar. I was able to take several books to give to the students at the school and also some books for the school library. When we arrived several hundred of the NKJV Bibles and New Testament's were there. We divided them among the men to take back to there areas and give to those in need of a Bible. Bro. Sedrack Sikulimba is one of the teachers at this school. He graduated with his BA in Bible with our International College of The Bible last April. It was good to get to meet him and spend some time with him. We had 20 new students to sign up for our distance learning program while we were there. During the next few weeks we will be sending each of these men a box of books and their assignments for their first 10 classes.

I am still trying to replace 200.00 per month of support that was lost. Some of our supporting churches have indicated that they may be able to increase their support a little to help out with our lost funds. If you can brethren please increase just a little starting the first of the year. We appreciate the support you brethren give toward our work.

I received another report from bro. Godfrey in Livingstone, Zambia concerning the mission money we left for him to take the students out for


"Dear bro. Gilbert,

On Sat. Oct. 2^{nd} we took all the students to Kazungula to evangelize the area. We used both vehicles. We did door knocking and door to door preaching and one person was baptized. The money we used during this trip was 350,140 K (\$75.00). On Sunday 3^{rd} Peter took students to Kazungula for church service and he used 100,000 K (\$22.00). I also took students to Kazungula on Sun. the 10th. We used 124, 380 K (\$27.00). Also Peter took the students to a church that meets at a farm on Oct. 10. This farm is along the Lusaka road. He used 100,000 K (\$22.00). We are so grateful for the support you are giving the school. Your support is helping us take the gospel to the lost."

Each year while we are there we try to leave them 300.00 to 500.00 for fuel so they can take the students out for evangelism. The cost of fuel there is still about \$8.00 per gallon. We are glad to help them. One soul was baptized due to their trip, that's wonderful!
