

Dear brethren,

Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. On Sunday night March 29, 2015 Carolyn and I departed for a trip to Malaysia. This was my 10th trip to Malaysia and Carolyn's 8th. We returned home on Tuesday night May 5th. While we were in Malaysia I had the privilege of preaching and teaching for 5 different congregations. Carolyn was able to help with some classes for ladies and help with the Bible school classes and materials. Our brethren in Malaysia are facing many challenges living, working and worshiping in a Muslim country. I always enjoy getting to visit and work with these good brethren in Malaysia. During the past 2 years some of the congregations in Malaysia have wanted to help us with the purchasing of Bibles and New Testaments for Africa. I told them last year that I would bring my slides and show them some of the congregations and individuals there gave funds to purchase Bibles, New Testaments and to print and ship several thousand Gospel tracts. We want to thank these good brethren for their help with our work in Africa. One thing I have noticed about our brethren in Malaysia is that they are very evangelistic. They are always working to start new congregations in their own country and to evangelize in China, India and other parts of the world. We appreciate these good brethren.

One of the projects we have been working on is the printing of 3,000 song books in Luo for the brethren in Kenya. Our thanks to bro. Garland Robinson for his help in printing much of our material. We just got these printed and hope to have them boxed and ready to ship out in the next few weeks. We are also ordering several cases of NKJV Bibles and New Testaments to ship to several different locations in Africa. We also plan to ship several text books and library books to some of the preacher schools we are currently working with. We will also purchase several Bibles in local languages while we are there. These Bibles cost about \$11.00 each.

We have purchased our tickets for the trip to Africa in August and are getting things ready for the trip. Each man going will try to bring about 10 or 12 good used suits for the preachers at the schools. This year Carolyn and I plan to stay in Zambia for 3 weeks then go on to Uganda and Kenya for another 3 weeks. We plan to visit with 6 of the 10 preacher schools we are working with. Some of these schools will have their graduation while we are visiting with them. I am trying to get an exact number of the men who will be graduating. I believe there will be around 60 men graduating. I hope we can raise enough funds to purchase a bike for each of these men who are graduating. This is a good work and a much needed item for these preachers. These bikes cost \$100.00 each. The 2 new schools we are working with are doing fine and several students are growing and learning more of God's Word.
